Postdocs will work closely with both Research Institute and Harvard or Umass Lowell faculty, and have a joint appointment at both institutions. This is a full-time position, with excellent salary and benefits, and a one-year appointment beginning in the summer of 2010, that is generally renewed for a second year.
